Prior to joining NRT, Mr. Shibia worked for the International Livestock Research Institute (ILRI) in the capacity of the Field Project Manager for the first index Based Livestock Insturance project, protecting pastoralists against severe livestock losses due to drought. Before joining ILRI, he worked with Kenya Agriculture Livestock Research Organisation as Research Scientist in charge of grazing management program at the arid and semi-arid research Centre. Shibia has vast experiences implementing participatory learning and reseatch as well as environmental and social impact assessments. He has close to 20 years of work experience with mobile pastoralists of Northern Kenya and Southern Ethiopia. He holds a Msc. In Natural Resource Management (Human Ecology) from Egerton University, Kenya, and a Bsc. In Wildlife Management from Moi University.
